

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-2139

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11.40,
ENTITLED “TRUCK TRAFFIC,” OF TITLE 11, ENTITLED
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,” OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester (the “Village”) are expressly authorized, pursuant to section 11-208(a)(7) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208(a)(7)), to restrict the size, weight and load of vehicles operated on roadways under the jurisdiction and control of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to amend Section 11.40.020, entitled “Westchester Boulevard - Limitations,” and to delete Section 11.40.030, entitled “Local service drive of Congress Street Expressway – Portion prohibited,” of Chapter 11.40, entitled “Truck Traffic,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Section 11.40.020, entitled “Westchester Boulevard - Limitations,” of Chapter 11.40, entitled “Truck Traffic,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

11.40.020. Westchester Boulevard – Limitations.

- (a) It is unlawful to drive any commercial truck or truck tractor, except for the purpose of making a delivery, conducting business, or providing services (and then for one block only) on Westchester Boulevard or any other boulevard hereafter named in the Village of Westchester.
- (b) Any vehicle owned or operated by the Village of Westchester, any government agency, or any public utility shall be exempt from the provisions of this Section.

Section 2: Section 11.40.030, entitled “Local service drive of Congress Street Expressway – Portion prohibited,” of Chapter 11.40, entitled “Truck Traffic,” of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 3: The Director of Public Works, or his designee, is hereby authorized to erect the necessary signage to alert drivers of commercial trucks of the restrictions contained in this Ordinance.

Section 4: Any ordinance or a portion of any ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby expressly repealed solely to the extent of said conflict.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law, and after the installation of appropriate signage.


