

## ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - \_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE  
ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNTS OF COMPENSATION FOR THE VILLAGE  
PRESIDENT, VILLAGE CLERK AND THE VILLAGE TRUSTEES FOR TERMS  
COMMENCING IN MAY 2017 AND THEREAFTER**

**WHEREAS**, the elected officers of the Village of Westchester (“Village) include the Village President, Village Clerk and Board of Trustees, of which there are six trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 3.1-50-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the corporate authorities of a municipality may fix the salaries of all officers who hold elective office for a definite term in an ordinance other than the appropriation or budget ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to fix the salaries, by ordinance, of the Village President, Village Clerk and Village Trustees of the Village of Westchester.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 2.08, entitled “Village President”, of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel”, of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 2.08.100, as follows:

**2.08.100 Compensation of Village President**

Commencing in May 2017, the compensation of a Village President for a term of office commencing on or after the inauguration of the Village President following the April 2017 Consolidated Election shall be Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) per year.

**Section 2.** Chapter 2.12, entitled “Board of Trustees”, of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel”, of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 2.12.210, as follows:

**2.12.210 Compensation of Trustees**

Commencing in May 2017, the compensation of Trustees whose terms of office commence on or after the inauguration of Trustees following the April 2017 Consolidated Election shall be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per year.

**Section 3.** Section 2.20.150, entitled "Compensation – Payment of fees", of Chapter 2.20, entitled "Village Clerk", of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

For the faithful performance of all duties required of the Village Clerk by the statutes of the state and ordinances of the Village, and in lieu of all fees and compensation allowed by him or her by the statutes of the state as full compensation for all services required or imposed by any or all laws, and also as full compensation for all additional duties imposed or services required by any such statutes or ordinances, the clerk shall be allowed and paid such sum or sums as the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester shall annually appropriate in each village fiscal year per year, to be paid in equal monthly installments. The Village Clerk shall pay into the treasury of the Village, all such fees collected by him or her, and also all fees and compensation paid to him or her by any person for his or her services as such Village Clerk for certified copies of documents or otherwise, or in the discharge of the duties hereinbefore mentioned, upon the date of each regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, and he or she shall make such payment to the Village Treasurer of such fees and all other moneys of the Village received or collected by him or her. The Village Clerk shall also report to the Board of Trustees at each regular meeting, the amount of all moneys received and turned over by him or her, showing by whom and for what purpose the respective amounts were paid to him or her.

Notwithstanding the above, commencing in May 2017, the compensation of a Village Clerk whose term of office commences on or after the inauguration of the Village Clerk following the April 2017 Consolidated Election shall be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per year.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.
