

ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 2173

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ENTITLED “ONE-WAY STREETS”  
OF TITLE 11, ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE  
WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester are expressly authorized, pursuant to Section 11-708 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208), to designate any roadway upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one direction at all or such times as shall be indicated by traffic control devices; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester have determined that it is necessary, proper and in the best interest of the Village of Westchester to amend Chapter 20, entitled “One-Way Streets”, of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** Section 11.20.010, entitled “Designated”, of Chapter 20, entitled “One-Way Streets”, of Title 11, entitled, “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**11.20.010 – Designated.**

- (a) The following streets are designated as one-way streets:
- (1) Newcastle Avenue between Kent Street and Canterbury Street is designated as a one-way street permitting southbound traffic only, during school days, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.

- (2) Hull Avenue between Canterbury Street and Kent Street is designated as a one-way street permitting northbound traffic only, during school days, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.
- (3) Kent Street from Newcastle Avenue to Hull Avenue is designated as a one-way street permitting westbound traffic only, on Sundays, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

**Section 3.** The Director of Public Works is hereby directed and authorized to install the appropriate signage in order to enforce the traffic regulations enacted by this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** Any ordinance or portion of any ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed solely to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
