

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11.32.150, ENTITLED “TRUCK PARKING”, OF CHAPTER 11.32, ENTITLED “PARKING”, OF TITLE 11, ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”, OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester have determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the public interest to amend Section 11.32.150, entitled “Truck Parking”, of Chapter 11.32, entitled “Parking”, of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.32.150, entitled “Truck Parking” of Chapter 11.32, entitled “Parking”, of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

11.32.150 – Truck parking.

- (a) Except as provided in Section 11.32.155 hereinafter, it is unlawful to park any vehicle which is licensed to operate as a truck-tractor, a semi-trailer, a trailer, a truck bearing a class D license or above (as defined in the Illinois Vehicle Code) or tow truck bearing a license, or to permit any such vehicle to remain parked at any time on any street in the village, or on private property in said village located in a district zoned for residential uses, except for the purpose of making a delivery or a service call for a period of not to exceed thirty minutes, unless prior permission has been obtained from the chief of police or his/her designee.
- (b) Commercial vehicles parked or stored on property zoned for non-residential use must be used in the operation of the business which is properly licensed and zoned where the vehicle is parked or stored. Commercial vehicles shall be stored in parking areas located to the rear or side of the property, when such parking areas are available.
- (c) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars per day per violation.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.


