

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.102.220, ENTITLED “NUMBER OF LICENSES,” OF CHAPTER 5.102, ENTITLED “VIDEO GAMING,” OF TITLE 5, ENTITLED “BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS,” OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester (the “Village”) have determined that it is advisable, necessary, and in the best interest of the Village to amend Section 5.102.220, entitled “Number of Licenses,” of Chapter 5.102, entitled “Video Gaming,” of Title 5, entitled “Business Licenses and Regulations,” of the Westchester Municipal Code (the “Village Code”) regarding the total number of location licenses for video gaming terminals and the total number of video gaming terminal licenses issued in the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble clause to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** Paragraph (A) of Section 5.102.220, entitled “Number of Licenses,” of Chapter 5.102, entitled “Video Gaming,” of Title 5, entitled “Business Licenses and Regulations,” of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

- (A) The total number of location licenses for video gaming terminals issued under this Chapter shall not exceed five.

**Section 3.** Paragraph (B) of Section 5.102.220, entitled “Number of Licenses,” of Chapter 5.102, entitled “Video Gaming,” of Title 5, entitled “Business Licenses and Regulations,” of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

- (B) The total number of video gaming terminal licenses for video gaming terminals issued under this Chapter shall not exceed twenty-four.


**Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
