

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11.32.160
OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester (“Village”) find it advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the public to amend certain sections of the Westchester Municipal Code regarding parking during snow removal on certain streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.32.160, entitled “Parking on alternate sides between eight-thirty a.m. and four-thirty p.m.”, of Chapter 11.32, entitled "Parking", of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

11.32.160 – Parking on alternate sides during snow removal between seven a.m. and three p.m.

After a two-inch snowfall and except as otherwise posted (e.g. Section 11.30.020 of the Municipal Code), it is unlawful to park any vehicle, or to permit any vehicle to remain parked, between the hours of seven a.m. and three p.m., on odd-numbered sides of the street on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, and on even-numbered sides of the street on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays. . Any motor vehicle that has not complied with these requirements at any time during the specified time period shall be considered to be in violation of these requirements until said motor vehicle has been moved, in order to allow snow removal operations by the Village to be completed at that parking location. Odd sides of the street are defined as the south side of east and west streets, and the east side of north and south streets. Even sides of the street are defined as the north side of east and west streets, and the west side of north and south streets.

Determination of odd and even numbered sides of the street for cul-de-sac parking and other similar circumstances shall be made by reference to house numbers.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.




