

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11.32, ENTITLED “PARKING”,  
OF TITLE 11, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”,  
OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village of Westchester (“Village”) find it advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the public to Section 11.32.155, entitled “Recreational vehicle parking,” of Chapter 11.32, entitled "Parking," of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code and Section 11.32.160, entitled “Parking on alternate sides during snow removal between seven a.m. and three p.m.”, of Chapter 11.32, entitled "Parking", of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Westchester Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 11.32.155, entitled “Recreational vehicle parking,” of Chapter 11.32, entitled "Parking," of Title 11, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**11.32.155 – Recreational vehicle parking.**

- (a) No person, firm or corporation shall park any recreational vehicle or boat, whether self-propelled or towed, on any street in the village, unless specific permission by the village police department is granted, and said permission may not exceed a total of fourteen days in any one calendar year.
- (b) Any recreational vehicle or boat, whether self-propelled or towed, may be parked on private property, but only if said recreational vehicle or boat is parked within a garage, or on an imperviously paved area located either in a rear yard that is not adjacent to a street or in a side yard that is not a corner side yard.
- (c) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of thirty-five dollars per day per violation.

**Section 2.** Section 11.32.160, entitled "Parking on alternate sides during snow removal between seven a.m. and three p.m.", of Chapter 11.32, entitled "Parking", of Title 11, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**11.32.160 – Parking on alternate sides between seven a.m. and three p.m.**

Except as otherwise posted (e.g. Section 11.30.020 of the Municipal Code), it is unlawful to park any vehicle, or to permit any vehicle to remain parked, between the hours of seven a.m. and three p.m., on odd-numbered sides of the street on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, and on even-numbered sides of the street on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays. Any motor vehicle that has not complied with these requirements at any time during the specified time period shall be considered to be in violation of these requirements until said motor vehicle has been moved. Odd sides of the street are defined as the south side of east and west streets, and the east side of north and south streets. Even sides of the street are defined as the north side of east and west streets, and the west side of north and south streets.

Determination of odd and even numbered sides of the street for cul-de-sac parking and other similar circumstances shall be made by reference to house numbers.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
