

ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 2272

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2018 AND ENDING APRIL 20, 2019 IN THE VILLAGE OF WESTCHESTER

WHEREAS, the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019 was made available for public inspection on April 11, 2018 at the Village Hall of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing on the contents of the proposed annual budget for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019 was published on April 11, 2018 in the Suburban Life newspaper; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 24, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., pursuant to said notice, and all interested parties had the opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized to approve and adopt the annual budget by ordinance pursuant to Section 8-2-9.4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.4).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The annual budget for fiscal year beginning May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019, attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted and approved in its entirety.


Section 2. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.


