

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.56, ENTITLED “POLICE DEPARTMENT,” OF TITLE 2, ENTITLED “ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL,” OF THE WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.56, entitled “Police Department,” of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel,” of the Westchester Municipal Code establishes a police department within the Village and provides for the positions within that department; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village find it advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the Village to increase the number of police officers holding the rank of deputy chief from one to two and increase the number of police officers holding the rank of sergeant from six to seven by amending Chapter 2.56, entitled “Police Department,” of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel,” of the Westchester Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2: Section 2.56.010, entitled “Department Created,” of Chapter 2.56, entitled “Police Department,” of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

There is hereby created a police department in and for the Village. The police department shall consist of one chief of police who shall be the director thereof, two deputy chiefs, seven police sergeants, twenty-three patrol officers, one records clerk, one traffic clerk, and one community service officer.

Section 3: Section 2.56.120, entitled “Deputy Chief,” of Chapter 2.56, entitled “Police Department,” of Title 2, entitled “Administration and Personnel,” of the Westchester Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Deputy chiefs shall have the authority to direct and issue orders to all employees of the police department holding the rank of sergeant or any lower rank. Deputy chiefs shall be permitted, regardless of rank, to take promotional exams and be promoted to a higher classified rank than he or she currently holds, without having to resign as deputy chief of police.

Section 4: Any ordinance or portion of any ordinance in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed solely to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
