

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.102, ENTITLED "VIDEO GAMING," OF
TITLE 5, ENTITLED "BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS," OF THE
WESTCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly amended the Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1 *et seq.*), by increasing the number of video gaming terminals permitted to be operated on the premises of a licensed establishment; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Westchester desire to amend Chapter 5.102, entitled "Video Gaming," of the Westchester Municipal Code, in order to increase the number of terminals permitted to be operated at a licensed video gaming location within the Village from five (5) terminals to six (6) terminals, consistent with the Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1 *et seq.*).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Westchester, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The facts and statements contained in the preamble clause to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The definition of "Licensed video gaming location" contained within Section 5.102.010, entitled "Definitions," of Chapter 5.102, entitled "Video Gaming," of Title 5, entitled "Business Licenses and Regulations," of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

"Licensed video gaming location" means a licensed establishment, licensed fraternal establishment or licensed veterans establishment, all as defined in Section 5 of the Video Gaming Act and this Chapter, that holds a valid authorization granted by the Village permitting the licensee to operate one or more, but not more than six video gaming terminals at the establishment.

Section 3. Paragraph (b), entitled "Licensed establishment", of Section 5.102.200, entitled "Restriction of Licensees," of Chapter 5.102, entitled "Video Gaming," of Title 5, entitled "Business Licenses and Regulations," of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

(b) Licensed establishment. No video gaming terminal may be placed in any licensed video gaming location in the Village unless the owner or agent of the owner of the licensed video gaming location has a valid state location license issued under the Video Gaming Act and a valid Village location license and has entered into a written use agreement with the terminal operator for placement of the terminals. A copy of the use agreement shall be on file in the licensed video gaming location in the Village and available for inspection by individuals authorized by the Village. A licensed video gaming location located in the Village may operate up to six video gaming terminals on its premises at any time.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.




