Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, meeting rooms at the Westchester Village Hall are open on a limited access basis and physical attendance at this public meeting is limited to the lesser of 50 individuals or 50% room occupancy, with priority given to Agency officials, Agency staff and consultants, subject to social distancing guidelines. Public comments will be allowed during the Public Hearing, using the "raise hand" function in the Zoom app. The above meeting restrictions are authorized by the Open Meetings Act, the CDC directive (social distancing guidelines) and Illinois Governor Disaster Proclamation dated July 24, 2020 (Phase 4 Restore Illinois Plan), and Executive Order 2020-48 extending the Governor's prior Executive Orders relating to the COVID-19 pandemic and his implementation of Phase 4 of the "Restore Illinois" Plan (Community Revitalization Order - COVID-19 E.O. No. 45).
