Police arrived and spoke to the victim(s) who were walking their dog, when a gray four door vehicle with front end damage, unknown plate, dark tinted windows throughout the vehicle started shooting at them out the passenger window with a paintball gun. Victim(s) related the vehicle then sped off southbound towards Roosevelt Road. A third victim notified police of a similar incident who related that she was walking on Kitchner Street e/b towards Westchester Boulevard when a grayish 4 door sedan with dark tinted windows and front end damage drove alongside her and fired paintball rounds at her. This victim believes that there were four m/b juveniles were in the vehicle. Police are reviewing cameras in the area - **Under Investigation.**
